



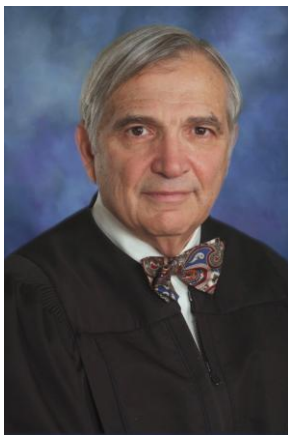

About our Speaker: Judge John M. Facciola



John M. Facciola was appointed a United States Magistrate Judge in the District of Columbia in 1997. Prior to being appointed to the bench, he served as an Assistant District Attorney in Manhattan from 1969-1973, and was in private practice in the District of Columbia from 1974-1982. Judge Facciola joined the U.S. Attorney's Office in 1982 and served as Chief of the Special Proceedings section from 1989 until his appointment as Magistrate Judge. Judge Facciola is a frequent lecturer and speaker on the topic of electronic discovery

Judge Facciola is a member of the Sedona Conference Advisory Board, the Georgetown Advanced E-Discovery Institute Advisory Board and he is also the former Editor in Chief of *The Federal Courts Law Review*, the electronic law journal of the Federal Magistrate Judges Association. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Federal Judicial Center. He wrote the chapter entitled *A History or Electronic Discovery in Managing E-Discovery and ESI From Pre-Litigation Through Trial* (Michael D. Berman, Courtney Ingraffia Barton & Paul W. Grimm, eds., 2011). He received his A.B. from the College of the Holy Cross and his J.D. from the Georgetown University Law Center.
